The ETeam is a group of independent professionals, each expert in his/her own field. Each team member assesses you independently and then discusses your results to provide you with an integrated ETeam report summarizing the main test findings, an interpretation of findings in terms of functional capacity and treatment recommendations.

<u>A physician referral is required</u>. The ETeam assessment provides objective data from multiple professional sources that may bring greater understanding and validate the types and extent of symptoms, abilities and disabilities you experience. We also provide recommendations for improving quality of life, including both traditional and alternative management strategies. ME/CFS, FM, MCS and the consequence of toxic exposures are chronic conditions. Symptoms may or may not improve as a result of this assessment.

Most of the services provided by a medical doctor, such as the psychiatrist on the team, are covered by Alberta Health Care. Unfortunately, the services provided by the other Eteam professionals are not covered by Alberta Health Care. In some cases, limited reimbursement may be available through extended health care plans such as Blue Cross or private insurance programs through employee benefits plans.
